Heawood were also at Melton Mowbray ( see portrait of Francis Salt) where Edward Prince of Wales used to keep a 'hunting box' . Emma later became well acquainted with the Prince when she moved to Melton & kept her own fish, game & poultry business as she supplied the aristocracy & catered events such as shooting breakfasts & hunt balls.

- Salt Family 1916 just after Frederick got called up for service WWI. Joined Leicestershire Regiment as a private.

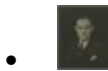
